Because the governments do not protect people against cybercriminals, in 2021 alone, cybercriminals stole from seniors more than \$3 B!

There were 3 victims of cybercrime every second in 2021.

The IRS is warning taxpayers of a recent spike in texting scams aimed at stealing both personal and financial information.

Reports: Cybercriminals are already exploiting ChatGPT to increase the frequency and sophistication of their attacks on people, create malware and exploit code without the benefit of actual coding

skills, and otherwise to intensify their assault on people and business.

Scammers use new technologies, and change tactics, to still money from people.

69% of state and local government organizations were hit by ransomware over the last year, according to recent research.

Since 2007, 109,000 home improvement scams initiated by criminals have been reported to the Federal Trade Commission (FTC), resulting in \$206.9 million in losses in roughly that same time period.

In 2023 there were 350% more attacks from cybercriminals.

Over 75% of Americans are attacked with holiday scams by cybercriminals.

Because the web is not protected by Governments, cybercriminals attacked a children's hospital.

In general, e-mail extortion data breach affects 2.4 millions of patients, and the FBI wants to assist victims.

Scientists determined that cybercriminals already put a big amount of AI-translated trash on the web.

Nearly all of AT&T's customers and many non-customers that AT&T wireless numbers interacted with may have been impacted in a massive cybersecurity incident. Cybercriminals illegally downloaded customer data from a third-party platform, gaining access to text and call logs from May 1, 2022, to October 31, 2022. While logs were exposed, the contents of calls and text messages were not.

Over 2.7 billions of cyberattacks were intercepted in 2023.

All Governments need to protect the people against criminals, including cybercriminals and phone criminals.

Cyberattacks are not inevitable – they can be easily prevented and completely eliminated when we'll have a quick implementation of what people want for millennia - peace, zero arms, adequate order (including zero crime and zero cybercrimes), good health, good education, good economy, harmony (with zero abuses), and prosperity for all.

Human error is known to be the primary cause of wars, conflicts, poverty, bad management, bad quality and production losses in all industries, but many human errors can be prevented.

5 October 2023. UN and Red Cross call for restrictions on autonomous weapon systems to protect humanity - the UN and the International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC) are calling on political leaders to urgently establish new international rules on autonomous weapon systems, to protect humanity.

The proliferation of Small Arms and Light Weapons (SALWs), in many regions on the Planet, is a serious danger for all.

15 September 2023. Global debt totals over \$235 trillions – it should be zero.

21 September - the International Day of Peace

Reports: At least five major ice ages have occurred throughout Earth's history of 4.543 billions of years: the earliest was over 2 billions of years ago (after 2.5 billions of years of very hot Earth), and the most recent one began approximately 3 millions of years ago, and continues today - we live now in an ice age. Currently, we are in a temporary warm interglacial that began about

11,000 years ago (when civilization began on Earth). The previous interglacial period was between about 129,000 to 116,000 years ago for about 13,000 years – which could mean that we have about 2,000 more years of temporary warm interglacial period, after which we will return to the cold (glacial) ice age for over 100,000 years.

Earth's hottest periods were the Hadean, the late Neoproterozoic, the Cretaceous Hot Greenhouse, and the Paleocene-Eocene Thermal Maximum (about 55 millions of years ago). One of the warmest times was during the geologic period known as the Neoproterozoic, between 600 and 800 millions of years ago. Conditions were also frequently sweltering between 500 millions and 250 millions of years ago.

The first mammals lived near the massive dinosaurs that dominated their age. After the extinction event that wiped out all non-flying dinosaurs, mammals began to develop. The Cenozoic Era, also known as "The Age of Mammals," began 66 millions of years ago, and continues into the modern day. Around 6,400 mammalian species exist in today's world. Mammals come in all shapes and sizes, and live on land and in water.

During the Mesozoic Era — from about 250 millions to 66 millions of years ago — the concentrations of CO₂ in the atmosphere were around 16 times higher than now, creating a "greenhouse climate" with temperatures on average six to nine degrees warmer than today.

Very good news: 14 August 2023. NIH unveils comprehensive proteogenomic dataset to help cancer researchers unravel molecular mysteries. Researchers from around the world will be able to use this publicly available resource.

People support the International Physicians for the Prevention of Nuclear War, which is a non-partisan federation of national medical groups in 63 countries.

Reports: Because of the huge bureaucracy, which exists around all activities, people are forced to pay over 40% more than the normal cost of any activity.

Reports: "Carbon-14 dating shows only 12% of atmospheric CO₂ added since 1750 is manmade".

Reports: There are so many sick people, and, because they do not receive the necessary medical treatment, so many bad things happen.

Reports: Censorship and abuses are increasing daily.

Customer satisfaction is nearing its lowest point ever, a new study suggests.

75% of the world's adult low-income population doesn't even have internet access.

Responding to an error with another error does not solve problems, only aggravates them.

All the bureaucracy and war-related stuff we hold onto, it actually holds us back from living well!

This conflict in Ukraine is like a big pipe leaking toxic chemicals on Earth – people kindly ask all leaders to stop the leak before the toxic damage becomes a serious problem for all.

Creating a family-friendly atmosphere on the planet is strictly necessary.

The medical problem of juvenile misbehavior in the world has good medical remedies, which must be applied much more extensively.

People congratulate NIH for supporting innovative technologies to help improve maternal health around the world.

All children in the world should have the technical possibility of participating in interactive classes taught via live video by experienced teachers from around the world.

Borderless media distribution is a necessity for all people.

World Unity Day – 20 July, when the first man from Earth walked on the Moon in 1969.

10 September 1996 - the Comprehensive Nuclear-Test-Ban Treaty (CTBT), which is a multilateral treaty that bans all nuclear tests, for both civilian and military purposes, in all environments, was ready to be signed - the Document has been signed by 185 countries and ratified by 170 of them, but, regrettably, it has failed to come into force. The position of eight states, for which the ratification of the Treaty is mandatory, prevents it from becoming a fully-fledged international document. Of the 44 States included in Annex 2, required for entry into force of the CTBT, all have signed with the exceptions of the Democratic People's Republic of Korea (DPRK, or North Korea), India, and Pakistan. Five of the 44 Annex 2 States have signed but not ratified the CTBT; they are China, Egypt, Iran, Israel, and the United States.

Note: People kindly ask all the countries to sign and ratify this important CTBT.

In many countries there is a budget deficit, but also an even bigger educational deficit.

The sick people cohort is growing in some parts of the world, and more medical assistance is needed.

Because there are not enough medical doctors, but there is plenty of bureaucracy, there are so many medical issues.

31 August 2024. Xinhua: The world's first professional, multimodal large language model (LLM) for the field of lunar science has been released in China, to significantly accelerate the processing speed of massive amounts of lunar data.

The new tool was debuted at the China International Big Data Industry Expo in Guiyang, the capital of southwest China's Guizhou Province, by the Chinese Academy of Sciences' Institute of Geochemistry, and the Alibaba Cloud Intelligence Group.

The Institute of Geochemistry has built a comprehensive "digital moon" platform with the world's most complete bank of data related to the exploration of the moon.

The LLM has created a "smart brain" for this digital moon. Ku Wei, vice president of the Alibaba Cloud Intelligence Group, said that the LLM identifies lunar craters and remembers them by size, depth and shape to provide scientists with important bases for their study of the moon's geological evolution. There are more than 1 million lunar craters with a diameter of over 1 kilometer, and countless smaller ones, according to Liu Jianzhong, a researcher at the Institute of Geochemistry. Identifying all lunar craters would be impossible if we were to rely on manpower alone, Liu said.

Researchers now only need to input an image of a lunar crater, and the LLM will determine its shape, size and age.

"The accuracy rate is more than 80%, exceeding our expectations," Liu said.

Scientists say that the progress and development of planetary science depends on two factors: the development of deep space exploration technology, and the levels of data processing and application.

Scientific research driven by big data is changing the science and technology development process, and the intelligence of the digital moon will accelerate China's lunar and planetary scientific research and innovation, according to scientists.

5 September 2024. Xinhua: China's lunar research station initiative welcomes new international partners.

China's ambitious initiative to launch an international lunar research station has gained new global cooperation partners.

During the opening ceremony of a two-day space conference held in Tunxi, east China's Anhui Province on Thursday, 5 Sep, the China National Space Administration (CNSA) and its counterpart in Senegal signed an agreement on International Lunar Research Station (ILRS) cooperation.

At the conference, China's Deep Space Exploration Lab (DSEL) inked memoranda of understanding with 10 institutions from countries including Serbia, Switzerland, the United Arab Emirates, Indonesia, Pakistan, Panama and South Africa.

Also among the institutions are the Belt and Road Alliance for Science & Technology, the Foundation for Space Development Africa, and Africa Business Alliance.

In 2017, the CNSA officially launched the ILRS cooperation initiative to the international community. To date, over 40

institutions from across the world have signed cooperative documents with China.

Wu Weiren, director and chief scientist of the DSEL, said in his opening remarks at the conference that the ILRS adheres to the principles of mutual consultation, joint construction and shared benefits to foster collaborative efforts with global partners.

The ILRS is a scientific experimental facility consisting of sections on the lunar surface, in lunar orbit and on Earth. It is designed to be an expandable and maintainable system capable of long-term robotic operation with short-term human participation on the moon. The project will be implemented in two phases. The first phase will see a basic model built by 2035 in the lunar south pole region.

Wu Yanhua, chief designer of the country's major deep space exploration project, said at the conference that this lunar facility would offer a comprehensive suite of functionalities including power provision, central command, communication navigation, Earth-Moon transportation, lunar exploration and ground support.

The basic model will be capable of conducting scientific research operations within a range of hundreds of kilometers around the lunar south pole, according to Wu Yanhua.

He extended an invitation to nations worldwide to participate in the program across different tiers, such as concept study-level, equipment-level, system-level and even mission-level.

Wu Yanhua also announced that China is planning to establish multiple organizations, including an international cooperation committee and a coordinating headquarters, to enhance global collaboration efforts.

5 September 2024. 20 September 2024. From Xinhua: Chinese scientists unveil world's first multi-modal Large Language Model in geographic sciences - On Sept. 19, 2024, the operating room of Sigma Geography, with many computers, started a geographic sciences multi-modal Large Language Model (LLM).

A geographic sciences multi-modal Large Language Model (LLM), the first of its kind in the world, was unveiled in Beijing on Thursday, 19 Sep.. It could support the integration of geography and artificial intelligence and help accelerate geographical discoveries.

The model, named Sigma Geography, was developed by a team of researchers from the Institute of Geographic Sciences and Natural Resources Research (IGSNRR), the Institute of Tibetan Plateau Research, and the Institute of Automation, all under the Chinese Academy of Sciences, and other organizations.

Sigma Geography can answer professional geographical questions, analyze geographical articles, undertake querying and in-depth analysis of geographical data, and draw thematic maps, said Su Fenzhen, deputy director of IGSNRR.

Compared to general LLMs, Sigma Geography has a deeper understanding of the language patterns, domain-specific terminology and professional knowledge in the field of geography, enabling it to better handle specialized issues, Su said.

In addition to answering geographical questions, Sigma Geography can also match the generated textual answers with geographical landscape photos, thematic maps or schematic charts to help users

understand the textual answers in a more visual and imaginative way, he added.

The research assistant function developed by the team, based on Sigma Geography, can complete processes such as concept understanding, data acquisition, information analysis and mapping according to user instructions, and ultimately generate professional geographic charts that users need.

The model could help broaden the general public's understanding of geographic sciences, and support academic research and studies to uncover major geographic scientific discoveries.

So far, Sigma Geography has been cited by over 10 papers published in academic journals such as sub-journals of Nature, The Innovation, and Earth's Future.

The team will continue to upgrade Sigma Geography, aiming to enable it to comprehend maps, and create a platform to facilitate scientists and research teams to collaborate through the sharing of data, models and research ideas.

Xu Rong, an official of the Ministry of Culture and Tourism (MCT), said the festival is expected to be joined by more than 370 guests from outside the Chinese mainland, including representatives of international organizations, foreign establishments of Confucian studies, and foreign diplomats.

The ministry will actively support Shandong in building the festival into an important platform for communication and mutual learning among global civilizations, thus raising the international influence of Chinese culture, Xu said.

This year's festival is jointly launched by the provincial government of Shandong, the MCT and the Chinese National Commission for UNESCO.

Nishan Mountain, located in Qufu, is widely recognized as the place where the philosopher was born. In 2010, Shandong initiated the Nishan Forum on World Civilizations. This year's forum was held in July.

China's peace plan, as the United Nations General Assembly gets underway this week.

Over the weekend, Ukrainian officials were circulating materials to members of Congress outlining Kyiv's strong opposition to the Beijing-authored plan, according to a source. Ukraine is looking to U.S. lawmakers to help make their case against China's plan.

Congress is one of the Ukrainian government's most important supporters beyond its borders. Without congressional backing, Ukraine wouldn't get critical weapons and equipment.

Beijing's plan, which calls on Western countries to stop enabling Ukraine's military strikes into Russian territory, among other recommendations. Ukraine would want to enlist lawmakers to help make their case to many of the world leaders and diplomats who will be at UNGA this week.

Kyiv's opposition to China's efforts focus in large part on what Ukrainian officials say is their short-term goal: pushing the United States to allow it to strike inside Russia as a way to establish a "buffer" against attacks on Ukraine.

Beijing's plan is described by the Ukrainian government as self-serving, with the goal of strengthening China-Russia ties by forcing Moscow to increase its dependency on China. Kyiv also warns that Beijing will try to enlist "one of the powerful European players as mediators."

"Europeans and Americans must clearly understand the inadmissibility of the idea of resolving any conflict by imposing China's ultimatum conditions (camouflaged under the expression "the will of the global majority") on the parties to the conflict."

27 September 2024. Xinhua: Chinese Foreign Minister Wang Yi meets with U.S. Secretary of State Antony Blinken on the sidelines of the UN General Assembly session in New York, Sept. 27, 2024.

The two sides agreed that the meeting was candid and substantive, and that China and the United States need to find a way to live alongside one another in peace in the indefinite future.

The two sides will continue to implement the important common understandings of the two presidents in San Francisco in last November, engage in dialogue and cooperation, and properly manage differences to work toward stable, healthy and sustainable development of bilateral relations.

Hong Kong improved across all three talent competitiveness factors in the ranking as compared to last year, according to the report. Its position rose from six to four in "readiness," from 15 to 13 in "investment and development," and the "appeal" ranking also moved up from 32 to 28.

In a breakdown by indicators subsumed under the factors, Hong Kong topped the ranking in the percentage of sciences graduates, and was among the global top five in the availability of finance skills, effectiveness of management education and remuneration of management.

Hong Kong's return to the top 10 in the ranking showed that the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR) government's efforts in education and talent admission have paid off, said a spokesperson for the HKSAR government.

By the end of August this year, over 360,000 applications were received under various talent admission schemes, with nearly 230,000 applications approved. During the same period, over 150,000 people of talent arrived in Hong Kong through various talent admission schemes.

Reports: A research team at the School of Engineering of the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology recently developed a new artificial compound eye system that is not only more cost-effective, but demonstrates a sensitivity at least twice that of existing market products in small areas.

Ukraine: Top official underscores need to protect civilians amid ‘massive’ attacks - The United Nations upheld the need to protect civilians in Ukraine as Russian attacks continue across the country, with at least seven people killed in Lviv on Wednesday, 4 Sep, according to the World Health Organization (WHO).

Note: People express condolences, and kindly ask UN to have intense discussions with both Russia and Ukraine to end the conflict.

5 September 2024. UN humanitarians continue to reach beleaguered communities stranded on the frontline in Ukraine. An inter-agency convoy delivered three trucks of aid to a community in the Kherson region on Wednesday, 4 Sep – the ninth this year that has managed to get through.

6 September 2024. UNICEF renews school protection call in Ukraine amid ‘deadly reality’ of attacks - Continued Russian attacks across Ukraine this week made for a tragic start to the new school year, a senior official with the UN Children’s Fund (UNICEF) said in a statement on Friday, 6 Sep.

6 September 2024. Reports: Ukraine continues to occupy Russian territory after a surprise incursion in the Kursk region.

In early August, Ukraine launched a military offensive in Russia's Kursk region. While Ukraine now controls approximately 1,000 square kilometers of Russian territory, Russian forces continue to advance rapidly in Ukraine's southeast.

On August 6, the Russian Ministry of Defense reported that Ukraine launched an offensive in the Kursk region, which lies in western Russia and borders Ukraine. Ukrainian authorities confirmed their involvement on August 12, and three days later, Ukraine's commander-in-chief Oleksandr Syrskyi announced the establishment of a military commandant's office in the occupied part of the Kursk region headed by Major General Eduard Moskalyov.

As of early September, Ukraine reportedly controls around a hundred settlements and nearly 1,300 square kilometers in the region (albeit estimates vary, the extent of the push is only 813 square kilometers according to the Ukrainian OSINT project "DeepState"), and has taken hundreds of Russian soldiers prisoner. President of Ukraine stated in a recent *NBC News* interview that Ukrainian forces are holding exactly the area they intended to, describing it as a buffer zone on Russian territory. He also claimed that Russia has mobilized over 60,000 troops to Kursk to counter the Ukrainian incursion, though this figure has not been independently verified.

In mid-August, President of Ukraine explained that the offensive was partly in response to the nearly 2,100 artillery strikes launched from Kursk into Ukraine's Sumy region since June 1. The operation aimed to secure Ukraine's borders against potential Russian advances into the Sumy and Chernihiv regions.

Despite these explanations, some experts believe the Kursk offensive's primary goal was to divert Russian forces from Pokrovsk in the Donetsk region. This objective appears to have failed, as Russian forces continue their advancement, having captured an estimated 355 square kilometers in the Donetsk region. Capturing Pokrovsk would sever a crucial supply line for Ukraine and facilitate further Russian advances in the southeast. Ukrainian officials recently ordered mass evacuations from Pokrovsk, which had a prewar population of around 60,000, with Russian forces now just a few miles away.

George Beebe, Director of Grand Strategy at the Quincy Institute for Responsible Statecraft, expressed skepticism about the Kursk operation, suggesting it may have been a strategic blunder. “There seems to be a great deal of skepticism about what this incursion is going to accomplish, and growing concerns that it was a blunder,” Beebe noted. “The Russians have not diverted significant numbers of forces from the front lines in Ukraine. They’ve stepped on the accelerator pedal.”

Note: People also heard that this actually may be the start of a peace process, initiated by some good mediators – people wish them quick success.

10 September 2024. Reports: On September 10, Ukraine launched one of its largest drone attacks in Russia since the beginning of the war. The Russian Ministry of Defense reported destroying 144 Ukrainian drones overnight, including several in the Moscow Region. In the town of Ramenskoye, about 40 kilometers from Moscow, a 17-story apartment building was hit and set ablaze. According to Moscow Governor Andrei Vorobyov, a 46-year-old woman was killed, three people were hospitalized, and 43 residents were transferred to temporary accommodation. Drone attacks were also reported in the Bryansk, Tula, Kursk, Kaluga, Voronezh, Lipetsk, and Oryol oblasts.

10 September 2024. UN: Security Council meets on latest Ukraine attacks - The Security Council in New York is debating the latest barrage of Russian missile and drone attacks that targeted multiple cities across Ukraine in recent days. The acting UN Emergency Relief Coordinator just told ambassadors that the human suffering during Russia's on-going invasion "continues at intolerable levels".

10 September 2024. Security Council: UN calls for safe, unimpeded passage of aid to Ukraine.

Note: People are very concerned about this human suffering, and kindly ask UN to have intense discussions with both Russia and Ukraine to end the conflict.

13 September 2024. UN warns of continued prohibited weapons transfers to Ukraine, Russia - Amid continuing prohibited weapons transfers to Ukraine and Russia during the ongoing war, top disarmament and legal officials issued calls on Friday, 13 Sep, for parties to the conflict to abide by international law and protect civilians.

20 September 2024. Reports: Ukraine claims to have successfully attacked an ammunition depot containing fuel tanks and explosives (among other things) in the Tver Region near the town of Toropets (680 km northeast of Kiev, and 375 km northwest of Moscow) on the morning of Wednesday, 18 September. The announcement was supported by footage of a large blast that was posted on social media, as well as NASA's heat reading and even earthquake monitoring devices, which also suggested that the depot held a significant amount of equipment. The regional government announced a partial evacuation of the area, but later claimed that order had been restored. However, throughout the week, the Russian Defense Ministry reported dozens of Ukrainian drone strikes in several regions. The strikes mostly occurred in regions close to the border of Russia and Ukraine, but Ukraine had previously struck targets as deep in Russia as 1,800 kilometers from the border, highlighting the inability of Russia's air defense to fully protect industrial and military establishments inside Russia's industrial heartland (albeit most drones are shot down). The successful hit also comes on the heels of Ukrainian President's ongoing negotiations with the U.S. and the UK for permission to use British and American long-range missiles to strike military targets inside Russia.

20 September 2024. Reports: Last week, Russia launched a counteroffensive in the Kursk region in an effort to regain control over its territories. Reports indicate that Russian forces have retaken a few villages. Oleksii Dmytrashkivskyi, a representative of the Ukrainian military commandant's office in Kursk, stated on Wednesday, 18 Sep, that Russia's counteroffensive has been halted. "They tried to attack from the flanks, but they were stopped there. The situation has stabilized, and today everything is under control; they are not successful," he added.

Last Thursday, 19 Sep, Ukrainian President commented on Russia's actions, stating that Ukraine anticipated a Russian reaction, and that this counteroffensive aligns with Ukraine's plans. He also mentioned that Russia intends to deploy between 60,000 and 70,000 troops to the region. A similar assessment came from the U.S., indicating that Russia would need up to 50,000 servicemen to push Ukrainian forces out of the Kursk region. Major General Pat Ryder, a spokesman for the U.S. Department of Defense, noted that Russian actions thus far have been "marginal," and analysts have not

observed the kind of mass or quality necessary to quickly drive Ukrainian troops from the area.

The Institute for the Study of War reported that Ukrainian forces recently made advances in the Glushkovsky district of the Kursk region. Geolocated footage published on Tuesday shows Ukrainian forces advancing east of Krasnooktyabrskoye, located southwest of Glushkovo. Russian sources, including the Russian Ministry of Defense, claimed on Wednesday, 18 Sep, that their forces repelled Ukrainian attacks near Veseloye (southwest of Glushkovo), Medvezhye (southeast of Veseloye), and Novy Put (south of Veseloye).

26 September 2024. Xinhua: Chinese Foreign Minister Wang Yi said in New York on Tuesday, 24 Sep, that all parties should be truly committed to promoting peace talks on the Ukraine issue. Wang made the remarks at the United Nations headquarters while attending a Security Council high-level meeting on the situation in Ukraine. The Security Council should serve as a bridge between differences and contradictions, an advocate of seeking common ground while shelving differences, a defender of common security, and a builder of lasting peace, he said.

Wang put forward three propositions in this regard:

Firstly, it is necessary to enhance the sense of crisis in cooling down the situation. Weapons of mass destruction should not be used, nuclear facilities devoted to peaceful purposes such as nuclear power plants should not be attacked, and civilians and civilian facilities should not be targeted, the envoy said.

Secondly, it is necessary to enhance the sense of responsibility in promoting peace talks. Dialogue and negotiation are the only viable way out of the Ukrainian crisis, he noted, urging the international community to seize the current opportunity to form joint efforts to promote peace talks.

Thirdly, it is necessary to enhance the sense of urgency in managing spillovers. China calls on the international community to strengthen cooperation on energy, finance, trade, food security and the protection of key infrastructure such as oil and gas pipelines, so as to jointly maintain the stability and smooth flow of global industrial and supply chains, Wang said.

China is not a creator of the Ukraine crisis, nor is it a party concerned, the top Chinese diplomat noted. China has always sided with peace, and maintained contact with all parties, including Russia

and Ukraine, he added. Wang called on the international community to join hands to uphold a vision of common, comprehensive, cooperative and sustainable security.

In addition to the increasingly difficult situation in the Middle East, the meeting also focused on the common commitment to support Ukraine's territorial integrity, and pursue a just and lasting peace. With regard to the debate on Security Council reform, the two leaders reiterated their shared commitment in the context of the 'United for Consensus' group, supporting a solution inspired by the principles of equality, democracy and representativeness, which therefore excludes the creation of new permanent seats.

On a bilateral level, President Meloni and President Erdoğan reaffirmed the shared desire to hold a summit between their two governments, and a business forum as soon as possible, in order to further strengthen the bilateral relationship.

25 September 2024. President of Russia met at the Kremlin with President of the Grand National Assembly of Türkiye, Numan Kurtulmus, who is in Russia on an official visit.

The President mentioned: President of Türkiye, Recep Tayyip Erdoğan, and I met in Astana, and we will see each other again at the BRICS summit in Kazan in October, where we are scheduled to have a bilateral meeting.

The PM also reiterated Italy's commitment to the Caucasus region's stability and prosperity, as well as its support for the normalization of relations between Armenia and Azerbaijan, with the goal of achieving lasting peace. The PM highlighted that the European Union's role forms an integral part of this process and that cooperation with the EU can open new opportunities for the entire region, also in terms of connectivity. The meeting also provided an opportunity for the two leaders to have an in-depth discussion on the main issues on the international agenda, and to explore common synergies in the context of the Mattei Plan.

Following the meeting, ENI and SOCAR signed three memoranda of understanding in the areas of energy security, the reduction of greenhouse gas emissions, and the biofuel production chain.

It is already carrying out strikes using unmanned aerial vehicles and other means. But using Western-made long-range precision weapons is a completely different story.

The fact is that – I have mentioned this, and any expert, both in our country and in the West, will confirm this – the Ukrainian army is not capable of using cutting-edge high-precision long-range systems supplied by the West. They cannot do that. These weapons are impossible to employ without intelligence data from satellites which Ukraine does not have. This can only be done using the European Union’s satellites, or US satellites – in general, NATO satellites. This is the first point.

The second point – perhaps the most important, the key point even – is that only NATO military personnel can assign flight missions to these missile systems. Ukrainian servicemen cannot do this.

Therefore, it is not a question of allowing the Ukrainian regime to strike Russia with these weapons or not. It is about deciding whether NATO countries become directly involved in the military conflict or not.

If this decision is made, it will mean nothing short of direct involvement – it will mean that NATO countries, the United States, and European countries are parties to the war in Ukraine. This will

mean their direct involvement in the conflict, and it will clearly change the very essence, the very nature of the conflict dramatically. This will mean that NATO countries – the United States and European countries – are at war with Russia. And if this is the case, then, bearing in mind the change in the essence of the conflict, we will make appropriate decisions in response to the threats that will be posed to us.

The summit aims to promote the unworkable Ukrainian formula as the sole basis for resolving the conflict, seeking international support and using it as a platform to issue Russia an ultimatum for surrender.

The spokesperson reiterated that Russia does not reject a diplomatic resolution to the crisis, and remains open to discussions on serious proposals that reflect the situation on the ground, evolving geopolitical realities, and the initiative proposed by Russian President on June 14.

"Without Russia, and without taking its interests into account, achieving a fair and sustainable resolution is impossible," the spokesperson said, and criticized Kiev and Western nations for focusing on war rather than peace, citing recent Ukrainian attacks on the Kursk region, and requests for long-range NATO weapons capable of striking deep into Russian territory.

...The first one concerns developing nature-like technologies. The second one – a follow-up to nature-like technologies – is a genetic and behavioral programme, and a programme for creating mega-installations across the country.

Next, the agricultural programme, in which we deal with the research and genetic part. On top of it, we operate as the lead research organization for expanding the nuclear complex.

Plus, microelectronics. We are working on neuromorphic microelectronics.

We own nearly 100% of the research network infrastructure, including the entire supercomputer sector, with all existing 20,000 kilometers of networks. We are also working on a quantum network, which is located within this compound as well.

The Kurchatov Institute includes about 30 institutes.

Plus, fundamental physics, especially now that collaboration with CERN, and other Western projects, has come to an end. Huge numbers of researchers, most of them the Kurchatov Institute employees, have come back, meaning that restarting fundamental research is a key priority as well.

Plus, our traditional research in the nuclear energy. We have built new nuclear power plants, such as a nuclear battery for Arctic exploration, which is advancing quickly.

Plus, our Sevmash project. We have developed, specifically for Gazprom, a manned underwater vehicle for two operators, which can dive to a depth of 2,200 meters to monitor the TurkStream gas pipeline. It is a manned vehicle. We teamed up with Gazprom to build a remotely operated vehicle which can be deployed from this vehicle and do inspections, while it remains connected to the vehicle with a cable.

... we have developed a unique simulator, an exact replica. You sit in the cabin, descend, and experience a real-life simulation.

In addition to that, we were fully in charge of bringing things up to code in the Arctic, rehabilitation. We have developed a whole new type of nuclear power. Here is the battery. We have the Yelena plant, a factory-built battery, which generates up to 1 megawatt of electricity, and up to 15 megawatts of heat. These local plants do the job in the Arctic where there are no major consumers and no chance to build a grid or a major power plant.

We signed an agreement with Yakutia.

Moreover, nuclear energy in outer space traditionally involves direct energy conversion.

What is direct conversion all about? Currently, reactor heat is converted into steam, which makes turbines rotate. This is not direct conversion. Direct conversion involves thermoelectric elements, specific substance. You surround the plant with these elements some of which are hot, and others are cold, and the heat gets converted into electricity without any moving parts or anything.

This is the essence of all spacecraft propulsion systems. We have been addressing this issue for many years. Today, the entire space exploration is linked to two key aspects. The first is entirely new engines. If we think about this, we will see that we fly into space, on a cannonball. Our RD-180 engine operates for 300 seconds, providing an impulse that kick-starts a rocket, allowing us to fly along ballistic trajectories, but we are unable to adjust them. But we need to land on the Moon. We have now developed prototype engines that offer an entirely different thrust, and completely new opportunities for deep-space missions. This is the first aspect.

For example, we have developed a lunar station that functions as a prototype Selena battery. We are now focusing on one thing at a time and trying to promote it as much as possible.

The same applies to materials - our institute now possesses the world's largest materials science potential. Absolutely everything that flies has been developed at the Institute of Aviation Materials, which is part of the Kurchatov Institute.

We are now establishing an integrated materials science Center that will include the Prometei Institute and the All-Russian Institute of Aviation Materials, as their equipment is one and the same, and Rosatom has consistent requirements.

We are often asked about our priorities. We have only two, or perhaps three, priorities, but we focus on the first two. First, any human thought that is generated emerges in the form of materials. For example, when a person conceives a picture, they need paints, canvas, an easel, etc. to create it. A person who has conceived a melody needs a grand piano, or another musical instrument, as well as sheet music and ink. Essentially, any item is a material, and energy is needed to create a material. Thus, energy and materials are two eternal civilizational priorities.

The soul and intellect are the third priority. This is it.

19 September 2023. “Armed conflicts are an offense to human rationality,' Brazil’s Lula da Silva tells UN Assembly.

18 September 2024. President of Russia had a telephone conversation with President of the Federative Republic of Brazil, Luiz Inacio Lula da Silva.

The discussion focused on current issues relating to the further growth of the Russian-Brazilian strategic partnership. The two leaders reaffirmed their mutual interest in building up political dialogue and mutually beneficial cooperation in trade, agriculture, energy and industrial cooperation. President of Russia said Russia was ready to provide Brazil with disaster relief to cope with the wildfires raging in several regions of Brazil.

They also touched upon several international issues. President of Russia thanked our Brazilian partners for supporting the priorities of Russia’s BRICS chairmanship, and briefed the other party on preparations for the BRICS summit in Kazan scheduled for October 22–24. Both sides underscored their commitment to continuing joint work in key areas of cooperation within BRICS, including in the financial sector. They also emphasized readiness to deepen coordination both in the G20, which Brazil chairs this year, and on other multilateral platforms.

Luiz Inacio Lula da Silva reaffirmed Brazil’s interest in helping find solutions to resolve the Ukraine conflict, and President of Russia laid out Russia’s assessments on this matter.

The leaders discussed bilateral contact schedule, and agreed to meet during the Kazan BRICS summit.

Note: People support President Luiz Inacio Lula da Silva in his efforts to resolve the Ukraine conflict.

24 September 2024. UN paralyzed, challenges piling up, world leaders ‘going around in circles’, says Brazil’s Lula - President Luiz Inacio Lula da Silva on Tuesday, 24 Sep, called for a major overhaul of the United Nations, including a critical examination of the Organization’s nearly eight decades-old Charter, blaming the incapacity of the international community to engage in

sincere negotiations for the failure to find solutions to the world's problems.

Note: People agree.

26 September 2024. The UK Prime Minister met President Luiz Inácio Lula da Silva at UNGA this afternoon.

15 September 2024. Reports: The electoral authorities' decision to grant a legislative supermajority means that the governing coalition has the ability to unilaterally amend the Constitution. This has not happened since the 1980s, when the country had an authoritarian political system.

The Mexican government is pushing reforms that would end judicial independence, eliminate autonomous institutions providing oversight and transparency, reduce the political representation of minorities, and damage the independence of electoral authorities.

With these measures, the structures that have protected Mexico's free and fair elections are at risk, and the country's democracy is in danger.

"I wish you a Christmas of 'peace on Earth and good-will to all', today and always."

Reports: 12 January 2024. British MP Jeremy Corbyn, the former Labour Party leader, said the military action was "a reckless act of escalation that will only cause more death and suffering".

“It is utterly disgraceful that Parliament has not even been consulted. When will we learn from our mistakes, and realize that war is not the answer?” Corbyn wrote on X.

9 September 2024. The Prime Minister is launching a new coalition today (9 September 2024), to tackle knife crime and stop young people being dragged into violent gangs.

Note: People are glad to see this coalition, and emphasize again that this is a serious medical problem, and needs medical attention.

13 September 2024. The Prime Minister and U.S. President Joe Biden held talks at the White House this afternoon.

The leaders both welcomed the opportunity for an in-depth discussion on a wide range of foreign policy issues, including the situation in Ukraine, the Middle East and the Indo-Pacific.

With both conflicts continuing, they agreed that now was the time for a more detailed discussion focused on immediate co-operation as well as long-term strategy over the next few months.

On Ukraine, they heard from the Foreign Secretary and the U.S. Secretary of State about their recent visit to Kyiv. They updated on the courageous campaign of the Ukrainians to defend their territory and deter Russian aggression. They strongly condemned the transfer of lethal weapons to Russia from North Korea and Iran.

Both leaders agreed on the importance of sustaining support to Ukraine in all aspects, including military, economic and diplomatic, for as long as it takes for Russia to withdraw.

On the Middle East, they discussed the urgent need for a ceasefire deal, the imperative of ensuring much greater flows of humanitarian aid into Gaza and the deeply concerning escalation in the West Bank - including settlement expansion and increasing settler violence. They agreed to work together to tackle these concerns. The Prime Minister reiterated his view that the only viable long-term solution to this conflict is the establishment of a Palestinian state alongside the State of Israel, that provides security for both Israelis and Palestinians.

They moved on to discuss the Indo-Pacific region and agreed on the vital importance of our global defense partnerships, including AUKUS. They agreed to continue their discussions.

16 September 2024. More jobs for British people will be created thanks to nearly half a billion pounds worth of investment by Italian businesses into the UK, the PM has announced today.

26 September 2024. The Prime Minister met the United Nations Secretary General António Guterres at UNGA this morning. They discussed some of the most pressing global issues including Ukraine, Gaza, Lebanon and Sudan.

The Prime Minister underlined his commitment to working with the United Nations to tackle global challenges, including climate change and development.

The UN Secretary General thanked the UK for continuing to play a central role in the work of the UN.

The Prime Minister reaffirmed the UK's commitment to the principles of the UN Charter, human rights and international humanitarian law. The two agreed to work together to implement the Pact for the Future.

26 September 2024. Prime Minister Keir Starmer delivered a speech at the United Nations General Assembly. From this speech: Conflict touches more countries now than at any time in the history of this Assembly.

Around the world, more fires are breaking out and burning with ever greater intensity. Exacting a terrible toll in Gaza, Lebanon, Ukraine, Sudan, Myanmar, Yemen, and beyond.

The vast majority of humanitarian need in the world today is driven by conflict.

After 20 years of gains in tackling poverty, disease and ill-health, war is one of the main reasons that progress has stalled.

That is a catastrophe made by human hands.

That we recognize that our success in Britain can never be separated from events beyond our shores. Global challenges rebound on us at home. And to grapple only with the effects of war, poverty, climate change, pandemics or irregular migration when they arrive on our doorstep is to set ourselves up to fail.

We must work with others to solve these problems at root, to tackle the causes.

Britain is stronger when we do so. So we are changing our approach on the global stage too.

My message today is this: we are returning the UK to responsible global leadership. Because I think the international system can be better. We need it to be better.

People talk about an age of polarization, impunity, instability - an unravelling of the UN Charter. And I fear that a sense of fatalism has taken hold.

Well, our task is to say: no. We won't accept this slide into greater and greater conflict, instability and injustice.

Instead, we will do all we can to change it.

This is the moment to reassert fundamental principles and our willingness to defend them. To recommit to the UN, to internationalism.

To work together for peace, progress and equality.

Because it is right - yes, absolutely. But also because it is plainly in our self-interest. So we are ready to step up in a spirit of respect and equal partnership.

I don't claim solving these problems is easy. But there are positive, practical things we can do together.

This starts with addressing the rising tide of conflict and preventing a regional war in the Middle East.

I call on Israel and Hizballah: Stop the violence. Step back from the brink.

We need to see an immediate ceasefire to provide space for a diplomatic settlement, and we are working with all partners to that end. Because further escalation serves no one.

It offers nothing but more suffering for innocent people on all sides and the prospect of a wider war that no one can control, and with consequences that none of us can foresee.

This is intimately linked with the situation in Gaza where, again, we need to see an immediate ceasefire. It shames us all that the suffering in Gaza continues to grow.

The answer is diplomacy, the release of all the hostages, and the unfettered flow of aid to those in need.

That is the only way to break this devastating cycle of violence and begin the journey towards a political solution for the long term which delivers the long-promised Palestinian state alongside a safe and secure Israel.

We must also work together for peace in Sudan and a proper response to the worst humanitarian crisis in the world today.

We need to see greater action to deliver aid and to deliver peace.

The world cannot look away.

But, alone, that's not enough. That's not the limit of our responsibility. We must also work together to make the world less dangerous.

And so we have to face some hard truths. The institutions of peace are struggling - underfunded, under pressure and over politicized.

The entire framework of arms control and counter-proliferation - painstakingly constructed over decades - has begun to fall away.

Incredible new technologies like AI are being deployed for military use without agreed rules.

These are difficult challenges to grip and too urgent to ignore.

That's why the new Pact for the Future is so important. We must put new energy and creativity into conflict resolution and conflict prevention, reverse the trend towards ever-greater violence, make the institutions of peace fit for purpose, and hold members to their commitments under the UN Charter.

But again, reducing conflict is not the limit of our responsibility. Other global challenges impact us too.

First, we must change the international financial system to deliver a fairer deal for developing countries.

We will use our seat on the boards of the IMF and World Bank to argue for a bolder approach, to tackle unsustainable debt which is compounding poverty and inequality, depriving the sick of healthcare and children of education.

We must tackle the barriers to investment which choke off the flow of private finance.

Second, if we want the system to deliver for the poorest and most vulnerable then their voices must be heard.

We need to make the system more representative and more responsive to those who need it most.

So we will make the case not just for fairer outcomes, but fairer representation in how we reach them.

And this also applies to the Security Council. It has to change to become a more representative body, willing to act – not paralyzed by politics.

We want to see permanent African representation on the Council, Brazil, India, Japan and Germany as permanent members, and more seats for elected members as well.

Finally, to support this we will also change how the UK does things. Moving from the paternalism of the past towards partnership for the future.

Listening a lot more – speaking a bit less. Offering game-changing British expertise and working together in a spirit of equal respect.

We are ready to work with all UN members because the scale of the challenges we face demands it and our prosperity and security depend on it.

I say it again – all of this matters to Britain.

Mr. President, by tackling conflict, making progress in the fight against climate change and poverty, and reforming the international system, so that it's fit for the 21st century, we can realize the hope and the promise that shine through in the founding documents of this organization. Together, in all our interests, we can change direction from the dangerous, destructive path we find ourselves on and turn instead towards the rule of law towards cooperation, responsibility and progress. Towards peace.

Eisenhower, 17 January 1961: the former famous Five Star General in the Army, Supreme Commander of the Allied Forces in Europe in World War II, and the 34th President of the United States warned of the dangers of allowing a Military-Industrial Complex to take control: "In the councils of government, we must guard against the acquisition of unwarranted influence, whether sought or unsought, by the military-industrial complex". The Military-Industrial Complex is a term that denotes an interdependent relationship between a nation's military, economy, and politics, and it is valid for all nations.

On 20 January 1981, in Ronald Reagan's First Inaugural Address: "Government is not a solution to our problem; *government is the problem*." (Note: he was referring mostly to more than half of the government, which includes the bureaucracy and the military (plus NATO) – this is valid for all nations).

Republic of Germany, Olaf Scholz. The two Heads of Government discussed the main issues on the bilateral and international agenda, starting with Ukraine. At the European level, they focused in particular on migration issues.

Chancellor Scholz outlined the reasons behind Germany's recent decision to reintroduce border controls with neighboring Member States, and the further initiatives Germany has introduced to counter irregular arrivals. The two leaders agreed to maintain close coordination on this matter, also ahead of the next European Council meetings, with the aim of consolidating the link between the internal and external dimension of EU migration policy, in particular by strengthening policies regarding partnerships with migrants' countries of origin and of transit, returns, the fight against human traffickers and legal migration.

Xinhua: Australian researchers have discovered a doughnut-shaped (note: torus-shape) region within the Earth's liquid core that could deepen the understanding of the planet's magnetic field. (Note: The Earth has an inner core in the center, which is a solid ball with a radius of about 1,220 km. The liquid core (about 2,250 km thick, volume about 7.6 billions of km³, which is 0.69% of the volume of the Earth) is also called outer core, which is a layer of molten iron and nickel that is between the solid inner core and the mantle (2,900 km thick (46% of Earth's radius (6,378 km at the equator, 6,356 km at the poles) and 84 % of its volume) - the movement of this liquid generates Earth's magnetic field.)

In a study published on Saturday, a team of seismologists from the Australian National University (ANU) detected the region thousands of kilometers below the Earth's surface near where the outer liquid core meets the mantle. (Note: about 3,000 km below.)

Hrvoje Tkalčić, co-author of the study from the Research School of Earth Sciences (RSES) at the ANU, said that the newly discovered region sits parallel to the equator and is only found at low latitudes. "We don't know the exact thickness of the doughnut, but we inferred that it reaches a few hundred kilometers beneath the core-mantle boundary," he said in a media release. (Note: the torus could be between 3,500 km and 3,000 km below.)

Researchers discovered the region by analyzing waveforms generated by earthquakes for several hours after the origin times of large seismic events.

Tkalčić said the region had remained hidden until now because previous studies collected data with less volumetric coverage of the liquid outer core by observing seismic waves confined within one hour of large earthquakes.

Co-author Ma Xiaolong, a postdoctoral researcher at the RSES who completed his Ph. D. at the Chinese Academy of Sciences, said the discovery solves some mysteries about the dynamics of the Earth's magnetic field.

The research team believes that knowing more about the composition of the Earth's core is fundamental to understanding the magnetic field and predicting when it will cease or weaken.

"The magnetic field is a fundamental ingredient that we need for life to be sustained on the surface of our planet," Tkalcic said.

He said that the findings could promote more research about the magnetic field of Earth and other planets. (Note: it will certainly promote more research.)

Following the meeting, a Joint Declaration was adopted confirming the ambition of both Heads of Government to continue strengthening and deepening the strategic partnership between their two nations in all areas of common interest. Italy and the United Kingdom are connected by exceptional relations and continuous dialogue on foreign policy, defense and security, starting with the Global Compact Air Programme (GCAP), the strategic importance of which was reaffirmed by the two leaders.

During the meeting, particular attention was paid to countering irregular migration. The two leaders intend to boost cooperation in the fight against human trafficking and smuggling, focusing particularly on the judicial dimension, as well as in their partnership with countries of origin and of transit, building on the collaboration launched as part of the Rome Process, with particular regard to assisted voluntary returns. They acknowledged that strengthening coordination with international partners, also through Interpol and Europol where possible, is key in order to maximize efforts.

The leaders also discussed the depth of bilateral economic, cultural and scientific relations, and of bilateral ties in the areas of innovation and youth exchanges, as well as their intention to do more in all sectors, expressing particular satisfaction with the new investment decisions announced today in the margins of the visit.

Lastly, the meeting provided an opportunity for an update on the main issues on the international agenda, in particular the conflict in Ukraine and the situation in the Middle East.

18 September 2024. The Prime Minister had a meeting with former PM Mario Draghi at Palazzo Chigi this afternoon.

The long meeting centered around an in-depth discussion on Mario Draghi's report on the future of European competitiveness, which the Government believes raises several important points, such as the need for a greater drive towards innovation, the demographic issue, the sourcing of critical raw materials and control over value chains, and, more in general, the need for Europe to provide for appropriate instruments to implement its ambitious strategies – from strengthening the defense industry through to the dual transitions – without excluding anything a priori, including the possibility of new common debt. These shared priorities also mirror the Government's

work in Italy and in the European institutions. The leaders agreed to keep in touch to continue to discuss these issues in depth.

The meetings focused on global technological and IT development prospects, with particular reference to artificial intelligence, the opportunities to be seized and the risks to be prevented.

The different groups' plans to invest in Italy were also discussed, along with initiatives that can be taken to boost Italy's competitiveness in the most high-tech sectors, also given its strategic position in the center of the Mediterranean, in particular by leveraging Italian excellence in higher education and research.

23 September 2024. The Italian PM is in New York to attend the 79th United Nations General Assembly from 22 to 24 September. Earlier today, the PM delivered a speech at the UN Summit of the Future. From this speech:

Mr. Secretary General, Fellow Delegates, The Pact we have undersigned is the result of complex negotiations for which I want to thank the President of the General Assembly, the negotiators, and all the Member States.

The phase that now begins – the Pact's implementation – is even more complex and more crucial.

Faced with such a complex scenario, we have no choice but to act. I think it is clear to all that we live in a time of crisis; yet, crises always conceal opportunities. The word crisis, after all, derives from the ancient Greek term *krisis*, meaning choice, decision. Crises force us to question ourselves, to take sides, and do not allow for hesitation.

We all know that no State can effectively master current challenges on its own, and that is why Italy is a committed supporter of multilateralism, and of its most representative institution, the United Nations – the forum where each and every voice is heard, where we are called to learn, to understand each other and to respect each other. Of course, any organization is effective if its rules are fair and mutually agreed. That is why we are convinced that any reform of the UN governance, particularly regarding its Security Council, cannot disregard the principles of equality, democracy, and representativeness.

A reform makes sense if performed for everyone and not just for some. We are not interested in creating new hierarchies, and we do not believe there are Class A Nations and Class B Nations. There are simply Nations, with their own histories, specificities, and citizens, who all have the same rights, because individuals are born free and equal. This also means we must think about cooperation between Nations in a new way. Italy has done so, for example, with the Mattei Plan for Africa, an investment plan designed to cooperate with African Nations through an approach that is neither paternalistic nor charitable or predatory, but based on respect and the right for each one of us to compete on equal terms. It is our recipe to promote the development of a continent too often undervalued, build its stability, and finally guarantee one right that until now has been denied to too many young people – the right not to have to emigrate.

...artificial intelligence remains human-controlled and human-centric.

This is the role of multilateralism. Not a club where people gather to write useless documents crammed with good intentions, but – rather – the forum where we must tackle decision-making urgency, and where ideas must become actions, combining the different sensibilities. We must never forget that the decisions we make today will shape the world where our children will be living tomorrow.

The situation between Lebanon and Israel since October 8th, 2023 is intolerable and presents an unacceptable risk of a broader regional escalation. This is in nobody’s interest, neither of the people of Israel nor of the people of Lebanon.

It is time to conclude a diplomatic settlement that enables civilians on both sides of the border to return to their homes in safety.

Diplomacy however cannot succeed amid an escalation of this conflict.

Thus we call for an immediate 21 day ceasefire across the Lebanon-Israel border to provide space for diplomacy towards the conclusion of a diplomatic settlement consistent with UNSCR 1701, and the implementation of UNSCR 2735 regarding a ceasefire in Gaza

We call on all parties, including the Governments of Israel and Lebanon, to endorse the temporary ceasefire immediately consistent with UNSCR 1701 during this period, and to give a real chance to a diplomatic settlement. We are then prepared to fully support all diplomatic efforts to conclude an agreement between Lebanon and Israel within this period, building on efforts over the last months, that ends this crisis altogether.

26 September 2024. UN: ‘We have failed the people of Gaza,’ Guterres tells ministers - The UN agency that supports Palestine refugees, UNRWA, is the only “outpost of hope” left in the hellscape that is Gaza, the UN Secretary-General told a high-level ministerial meeting on Thursday, 26 Sep, in New York.

A personalized, adaptive deep brain stimulation system significantly reduced Parkinson's symptoms and improved quality of life compared with standard deep brain stimulation.

Researchers found that proteins involved in Alzheimer's disease inhibit glucose metabolism in the brain, suggesting a new potential approach for treatment.

Microscopic robots are capable of swimming through the lungs to deliver cancer-fighting medication directly to metastatic tumors.

From Harvard Medical School: Continuous glucose monitors, or CGMs, offer valuable and accurate insights into blood sugar levels, allowing some individuals with diabetes to make better-informed decisions about medications, diet, exercise, and overall diabetes management. A CGM is a device that can monitor blood sugar levels continuously throughout the day and night.

Unlike traditional fingerstick tests, which provide periodic, infrequent snapshots of blood sugar levels, CGMs measure glucose levels every five minutes, allowing a person with diabetes to know if their blood sugar is trending high or low. The devices offer greater convenience, accuracy, and potential for control for individuals with this condition. CGMs need three parts to work: a sensor, a transmitter, and a receiver. In older models, the sensor and transmitter are separate devices. But newer models combine the sensor and transmitter in one device.

The sensor is a tiny catheter that is inserted under the skin and held to the skin by an adhesive. It must be changed every 10 to 14 days

The sensor measures glucose levels every one to five minutes in the interstitial fluid between your cells. It then communicates those levels to the transmitter, which sends the glucose readings to a receiver or smartphone app.

Using advanced mathematical algorithms, CGMs analyze the data to provide users with insights into their blood sugar trends and patterns throughout the day and night. However, users should be aware that there is a delay of about 20 minutes between the levels the CGM displays and levels of glucose in the blood.

CGMs not only offer continuous monitoring, but can also sound alarms if glucose levels deviate from target ranges, enabling intervention to prevent dangerous highs or lows. It's important for a person with diabetes to maintain blood glucose levels within a target range to reduce the risk of short-term complications like dangerously low blood sugar (hypoglycemia), and long-term complications such as cardiovascular disease, kidney damage, nerve damage, and vision problems.

As continuous glucose monitoring provides a continuous stream of information regarding glucose levels, it enables patients with fluctuating glucose levels — which means patients with type 1 diabetes, for the most part — to either choose the right doses of insulin or for insulin pumps to choose the right doses. The benefit of CGMs is less clear in patients with type 2 diabetes, which is far more common than type 1 diabetes. Of the 38 millions of people in the United States with diabetes, 90% to 95% have type 2 diabetes.

That's the warning from the UN World Health Organization (WHO), which has appealed for much greater investment to help almost 1.3 billion teenagers globally.

The World Health Organization has established the following classification system for bone density:

- If your T-score is -1 or greater: your bone density is considered normal.
- If your T-score is between -1 and -2.5 : you have low bone density, known as osteopenia, but not osteoporosis.
- If your T-score is -2.5 or less: you have osteoporosis, even if you haven't yet broken a bone.

Harvard Medical School: The initial treatment for active rheumatoid arthritis (RA) is supposed to be aggressive. Doctors can pre-scribe powerful medications to slow the chronic immune system attack on the lining of the joints, and the drugs should be administered as soon as possible to help prevent crippling disability.

Unfortunately, most people diagnosed after age 65 (which includes up to a third of all people with rheumatoid arthritis) aren't getting optimal treatment, according to recent evidence.

11. Mathematics, Science, Technology, AI, Space

A small device can be swallowed and passed through the gastrointestinal tract to sample the full inventory of microorganisms in an individual's gastrointestinal tract. The device has the potential to advance research on the connection between resident bacteria and a wide range of health conditions.

A sweat-powered wearable has the potential to make continuous, personalized health monitoring effortless. An electronic finger wrap monitors vital chemical levels — such as glucose, vitamins, and even drugs — present in the same fingertip sweat from which it derives its energy.

In-space manufacturing of self-replicating machines uses freeform injection molding, which lowers weight and cost, and helps to overcome difficulties in composite manufacturing.

Brain-computer interface helps paralyzed man speak - Researchers developed a highly accurate brain-computer interface that allowed a man whose ability to speak was impaired by ALS to communicate.

23 September 2024. Researchers at the Department of Energy's Oak Ridge National Laboratory have successfully demonstrated the first 270-kW wireless power transfer to a light-duty electric vehicle.

Two new studies from University of Washington researchers introduce AI systems that use either video or photos to create simulations that can train robots to function in real settings.

AI research: OpenAI's o1 shows mathematical promise, while Insilico achieves AI drug discovery milestone.

Beyond OpenAI's progress, Salesforce is developing AI-powered "agents" to automate tasks like customer service and scheduling.

Artificial muscles propel a robotic leg to walk and jump - Researchers have developed a robotic leg with artificial muscles. Inspired by living organisms, it jumps across different terrains in an agile and energy-efficient manner.

Researchers have developed an artificial motor at the supramolecular level that can develop impressive power.

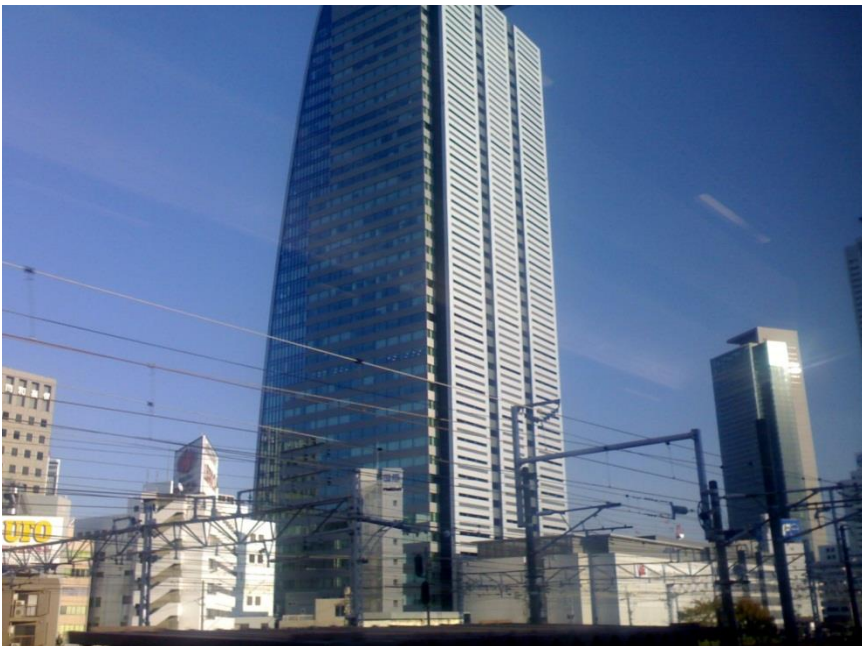
Reports: On 7 September 2024, Boeing's troubled Starliner spacecraft completed a successful uncrewed return flight to Earth.

"Kindness in words creates confidence".

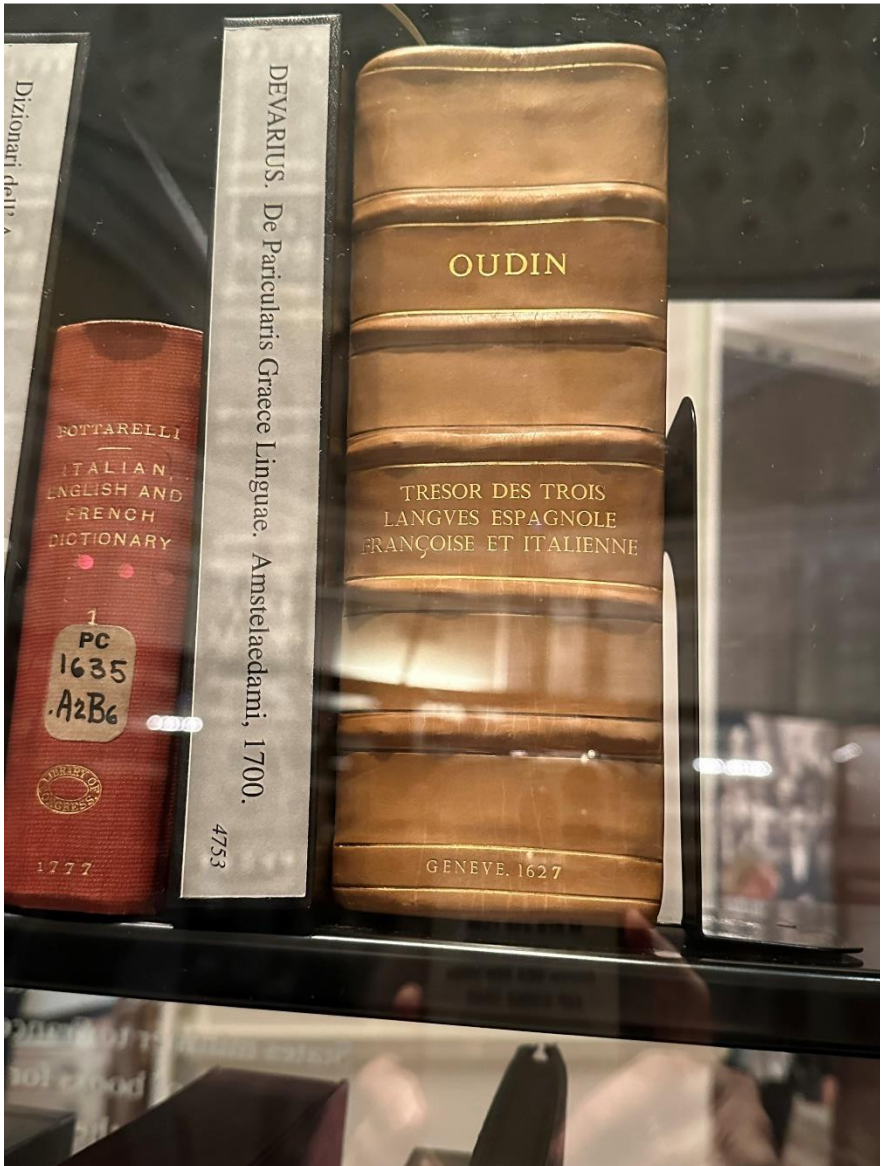


Rome: Center: Columna Traiani (113 AD) with a band (180 m) of carved reliefs, which winds around the Trajan's Column, regarding

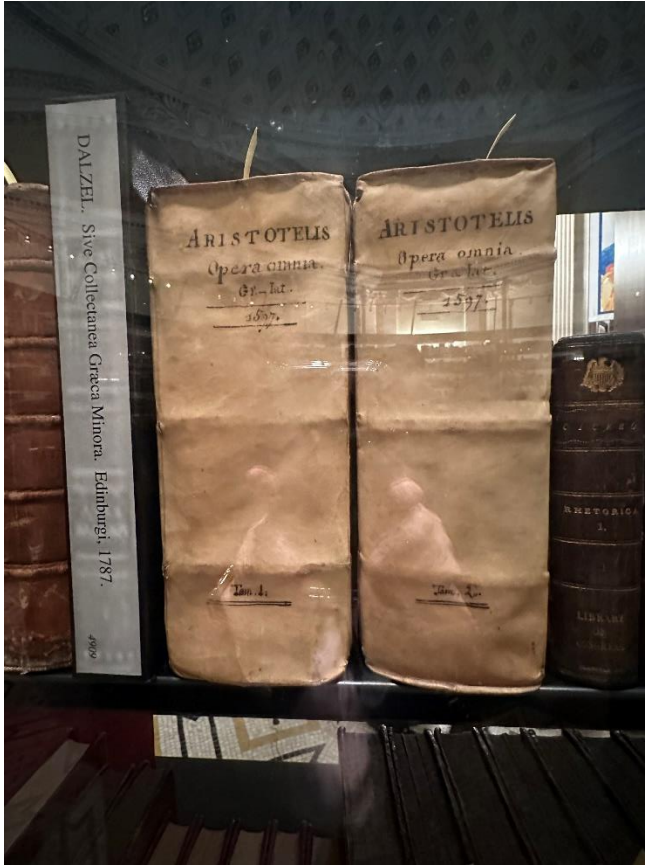
